

E-CIGARETTES

Among youth who vape, 84.7% used a flavored e-cigarette in the past month.

In 2021, 11.3% of high school students and 2.8% of middle school students had used e-cigarettes during the past month.

In April 2022, JUUL remains the most popular reusable e-cigarette device with 33.8% of the reusable market share, followed by Vuse taking 30.5% of market share.

Use of disposable e-cigarettes increased about 1000% among high school e-cigarette users from 2019 to 2020.
